

## LEGEND AND SUMMARY OF BEC YELLOW DAY RIDER TRAIL

**YELLOW** 11.1 miles  Clockwise loop.

**YELLOW EAST:** From the outdoor riding arena, riders start by turning left on gravel road toward the BEC barns to start the loop. Trail turns right up a short gravel driveway beyond BEC parking lot and into the woods. Trail runs through woods for about 9 miles before returning to the River again. Turn right along on River Rd., cross iron railed bridge over Dingle Creek, proceed on River Rd. to open field, turn right, and go into woods behind mares' pastures and proceed back to left turn onto gravel road below indoor arena, then turn sharp left onto gravel road back to BEC outdoor riding arena.

**STARTING AND FINISHING AT DAY TRAILING PARKING:** To reach the outdoor riding arena to start the Yellow Trail loop, take the main shared return trails (lots of colored arrows) that goes behind the Day Trailer Parking area for ½ mile to the riding arena and then follow the instructions above. Upon reaching the outdoor riding arena at the conclusion of the Yellow Trail loop, continue another ½ Mi. following white arrows on River Rd. to return to the Day Trailer Parking.

**Trail marked with black arrows on yellow diamonds of the trail color. Markers attached to trees or stakes.**



At turns, expect one or more warning arrows before the turn. Turn arrow for Yellow Trail.



There are confirming straight arrows after turns. Confirming arrow for Yellow Trail.



There are occasional "go straight" arrows along the trail. Straight arrow for Yellow Trail.



Yellow octagons with **Large Black X** mean **wrong way** for Yellow Trail. Do not pass.
