

## LEGEND AND SUMMARY OF BLUE EAST DAY

**BLUE EAST** 10.5 Miles  clockwise loop (with 4 mile shorter option).

**BLUE EAST:** The trail starts downstream on the gravel River Rd does a button hook coming back along horse paddocks. The trail then turns left into the woods and then goes through the open area created by Tropical Storm Helene, and then through more woods. At about 3 miles, the trail goes downhill on Fish Pond Rd. for about 0.1 of a mile. (see ALTERNATE SHORTER ROUTE.) Continue through the woods. At 10 miles the trail comes out to the French Broad River and goes downstream on River Rd back to the Day Trailer Parking.

**ALTERNATE SHORTER ROUTE.** The trail goes downhill on the gravel Fish Pond Road about 3 miles from the start. Stay on Fish Pond Rd, when Blue turns left uphill. Go past the BEC barns, continue on to River Rd. and turn right and go downstream on River Rd for about ¼ mile to return to the Day Trailer parking area.

### Trails marked with black arrows on blue diamonds. Markers attached to trees or stakes



At turns, expect one or more warning arrows before the turn. Example - turn arrow for Blue trail.



There are confirming straight arrows after turns. Example - confirming arrow for Blue trail.



There are occasional “go straight” arrows along the trail. Example - straight arrow for Blue trail.



Color-matched octagons with **Large Black X** mean **wrong way** on the loop of *that color octagon*.
