

LEGEND AND SUMMARY OF BEC PURPLE EAST DAY TRAIL

PURPLE EAST  10 Mi Clockwise Loop in the middle of out and back sections

PURPLE EAST: The trail starts downstream on River Road along the French Broad River. The trail climbs uphill from the Reflecting Lagoon with views of the Biltmore House on the right. The trail passes near the carriage barn and the hack stable in the Deer Park area, bears left along Deer Park Rd for about 1/3 mile, leaves Deer Park Rd, and then comes back along Deer Park Rd across from the sheep and lambs. After crossing the main paved Winery Approach Rd, the trail goes back to River Rd and downstream to the Estate bridge over the French Broad River. The trail turns around at that point and retraces itself until just beyond the sheep fields where it bears left and goes through woods for about 3 ½ mile before coming back the Deer Park area. The trail then descends with views of the Biltmore House on the left to the Reflecting Lagoon. From the lagoon the trail returns through the French Broad River bottom to the Day Trailer parking area.

Trails marked with white arrows on purple diamonds. Markers attached to trees or stakes.



At turns, expect one or more warning arrows before the turn. Left Turn arrow for Purple Trail.

There are occasional “go straight” arrows along the trail. Straight arrow for Purple Trail.



Purple octagons with **large white X mean wrong way** for Lime Trail. Do not pass.
