


## LEGEND AND SUMMARY OF BEC YELLOW DAY RIDER TRAIL

**YELLOW** 12 miles  Clockwise Lollipop (with shorter option of 8 ½ miles).

**YELLOW EAST:** Start downstream on the gravel River Rd, turn right about ½ mile and follow the gravel road into the woods. Go through the woods, the open area created by Tropical Storm Helene, and more woods. At about 7 ¼ miles the trail comes out to the French Broad River and the gravel River Rd. Proceed on River Rd. to an open fields with horse pasture on the right. (see ALTERNATE SHORTER ROUTE.) Turn sharp right and proceed through the woods for several miles before coming back to the French Broad River bottom. Proceed about ½ mile on gravel road back to the Day Trailer Parking.

**ALTERNATE SHORTER ROUTE.** Stay straight on the gravel River Rd. rather than turning right toward horse pastures at 7 ¾ miles. Continue downstream for ¾ mile on River Rd. to the Day Trailer Parking.

**Trail marked with black arrows on yellow diamonds of the trail color. Markers attached to trees or stakes.**



At turns, expect one or more warning arrows before the turn. Turn arrow for Yellow Trail.



There are confirming straight arrows after turns. Confirming arrow for Yellow Trail.



There are occasional “go straight” arrows along the trail. Straight arrow for Yellow Trail.



Yellow octagons with **Large Black X** mean **wrong way** for Yellow Trail. Do not pass.
